


PRESS RELEASE

Don't Get Duped!

It has come to our attention the existence of websites that are procuring tickets to shows in the Colonial Theater. These websites offer Zone Seating, meaning you choose a general zone of the theater where you'd like to sit and then the website procures them for you. They are selling these procurements for extremely higher prices than what we are charging for the show.

For example, we found a website selling Whose Live Anyway tickets. The screen shot on the right shows they are selling balcony tickets for \$111, but those same seats are only \$35 on our website. There is also no guarantee your party will be seated together.
