**Booth Information & Registration**

The seventh annual Snake River Roaring Youth Jam is a three-day arts festival filled with professional live performances and workshops, hands-on visual art activities, local live performances and great teen activities.

**Food Vendors** (all locations): \$300 for all three days plus refundable \$75 deposit  
(example *Applebee's, Dominos*)

**Non-Profit Food Vendors:** \$150 for all three days plus refundable \$75 deposit  
(example *Ucon Fire Dept.*)

**For-Profit Vendors:** \$300 for all three days plus refundable \$75 deposit  
(example *Apple Athletic Group, Ben Franklin*)

**Non-Profit Groups:** \$0 plus refundable \$75 deposit  
(example *Museum of Idaho, Art Museum of Eastern Idaho*)

The last day to register will be July 10. Please send your application earlier if possible as we limit the size and number of vendors by type.

Please make checks payable to the Idaho Falls Arts Council and cut a separate check for your deposit (\$75 for each booth reserved). The deposit will be refunded to you after the festival, provided all of the regulations have been followed. (Please see attached.) The full vendor fee must be received by July 30, 2010.

## Snake River Roaring Youth Jam Vendor Regulations

The following are important guidelines to ensure a safe event. Please follow them so we may refund your deposit at the end of the festival.

- Hours are from 10 am to 4 pm on August 12-14, 2010. All booths must be open during these hours. Setup and breakdown must take place before 10 am and after 4 pm.
- All vendors **must** check-in at the Idaho Falls Arts Council information booth located on the greenbelt across from B Street. Check-in time will be 8:30 am to 9:30 am and you will be directed to your space. **Please arrive on time.** Please do not arrive any earlier than 8:30. You will not be allowed to set up prior to that time. It is not ideal to set up after the festival has begun. The parking along the greenbelt also makes it very difficult to set up after 9:30 am.
- No one will be allowed to drive on the grass or walking path unless special arrangements have been made **PRIOR** to the event.
- Booth dimensions are 12' x 12' or smaller and each vendor must provide their own tent as well as chairs, tables, etc. Tents are highly recommended as shelter from the weather. Make sure to secure your tent before leaving for the night and if possible loosen the roof so it's flaps in the wind. It is very windy along the greenbelt at night and a simple shade tent will fall to pieces. It's important that you have a shelter tent that can withstand gusts of wind. The IFAC is not responsible for broken tents due to the weather.
- Food operators are required to follow all health department regulations and have all necessary licenses and city permits. The Health Dept. does show up to check.
- All power cords must be secured with duct tape or hooks. There is very little access to power or water on the greenbelt and it is imperative that you let us know your needs on your initial application. Power and water are available to FOOD VENDORS only.
- The following items **cannot** be sold: laser lights, plastic or real swords, knives, razors, or any object deemed to be a weapon.
- The Youth Jam will provide light security overnight, and you may leave your tent up if you choose. However, we are not responsible for items that you own or the tent itself. You should put any items away in a secure location for each night of Youth Jam.
- The festival will be held regardless of weather.
- Booth space will be limited in number and type and Youth Jam management has a right to refuse registration to any vendor.
- Your deposit check will be mailed to you after the festival providing all of the above regulations have been met. Refunds will not be given to those who decide not to attend after registering.

**The full vendor fee must be received by July 30, 2010.**
